New Auto Licenses Are To Cost More

South Carolina motor vehicle owners will pay 50 cents more for their 1949-50 licenses than they have been paying formerly.

A 1949 legislative act which revised the licensing regulations increased the highway safety fee from 50 cents to \$1.

This safety fee, which is included in the license fee, helps finance the highway patrol's safety program. Chief Highway Commissioner C. R. McMillan explained.

A 15-cent postage charge, instead of the previous 10 cents, also is authorized in the act.

The new schedule of fees, including postage:

"A" license, \$2.15, formerly \$1.60; "B", \$3.15, formerly \$2.60; "C", \$4.15, formerly \$3.60; "D", \$5.15, formerly \$4.60; "E", \$6.15, formerly \$5.60; "F", \$7.15, formerly \$6.60; "G", \$8.15, formerly \$7.60.

Licenses soon will be placed on sale, they have to be bought before Oct. 31.

Nine Cash Prizes Offered

Two-Acre Pasture Contest For Farmers Of County Is Launched

A 2-acre pasture contest for farmers in Kershaw county is being sponsored by the district supervisors of the Kershaw Soil Conservation District in cooperation with the Soil Conservation Service, Extension Service and Vocational Agriculture teachers. This is in keeping with the growing tendency for farmers in the county to increase the livestock on their farms.

The district supervisors of the Soil Conservation District are: L. O. Funderburk, Camden, chairman; James L. Sweet, Boykin; Finley Branham, Lugoff; Charles L. Truesdale, Blaney, and John M. Catoe, Bethune.

Assisting in sponsoring the contest are the Southern Cotton Oil Co., Commercial National Bank and First National Bank, C. V. Massebeau and S. P. West, of Camden; J. D. Bailey, E. T. Bowen, Blaney; C. W. Jones, John E. Baker, C. B. Mitchell, Bethune; Kershaw Oil Mill, E. D. Baxley, Kershaw.

Three kinds of pastures will be eligible for prizes in the contest as follows:

1. Dallis or Germuda grass with any combination of legumes.
2. Tall fescue and ladino clover.
3. Crimson clover and Italian rye grass mixture or small grain mixture.

Three cash prizes will be awarded in the contest in each class of pasture. In the summer pasture the first prize is \$60; the second \$25 and third \$15. In the fescue and ladino pasture the prizes are \$25, \$15 and \$10 and in the crimson clover and rye grass pasture, the prizes likewise as \$25, \$15, \$10.

Any farm owner, or operator, or member of his family may enter the contest. Entry is limited to one contestant per family. The contestant's pasture must be located within the county boundary.

All entries must be signed and filed with the Soil Conservation Service technician.
