"Winthrop College, June 11, 1920.
Dear Home Folks:—Today is our last day at this lovely place, Winthrop, where I have been for the past ten days attending the state short course. I just want to tell you some of the things I've learned, seen and done while up here. We have learned lots of new games at the gymnasium taught by Miss Lydia. She also taught us songs and many other interesting things.

"One of the most interesting things I want to tell you about is the trip to the poultry and dairy farm. We saw them making the butter which we used at the college and the huge incubators that held twenty-three hundred eggs. The chickens are beautiful.

We went in swimming Monday evening and certainly did enjoy it.

"You all can never imagine what a fine place Winthrop is until you have had the opportunity of seeing it as I have had and I wish every club girl could have that privilege. I have attended every meeting and have enjoyed every one; I am determined to do my club work well and get the most out of it for I realize it is quite a privilege to be a club member.

The examination for the award of vacant Scholarships in Winthrop College and for the admission of new students will be held at the County Court House on Friday, July 2, at 9 a. m. Applicants must not be less than sixteen years of age. When Scholarships are vacant after July 2 they will be awarded to those making the highest average at this examination, provided they meet the conditions governing the award. Applicants for Scholarships should write to President Johnson before the examination for Scholarship examination blanks.


