S. C. Gets Two Shaw Graduates

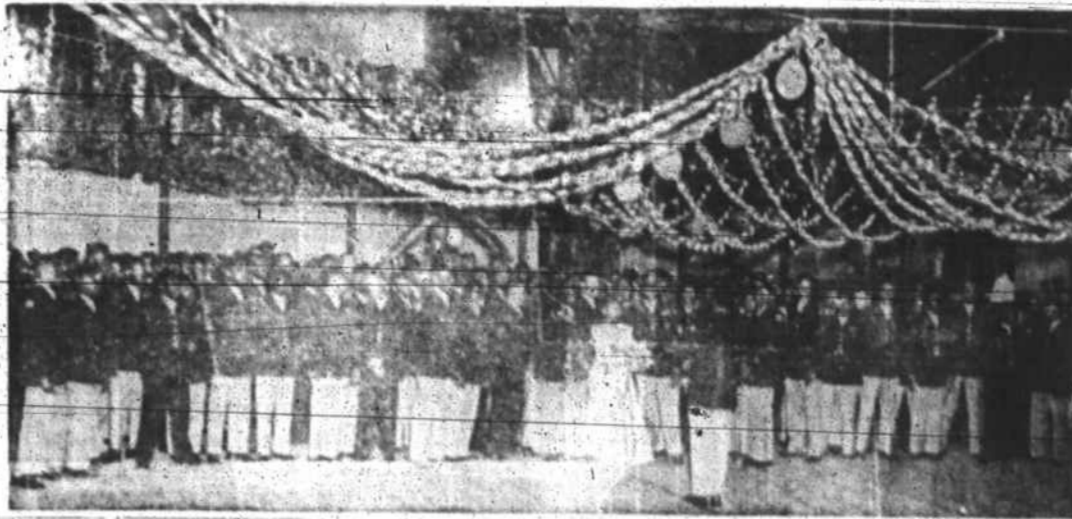
