

**Negroes On Team, Florida Cancels Bradley Games**

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. (ANS)—Officials at Florida State University Wednesday cancelled a football game with Bradley University of Peoria, Ill., after learning that several Negroes are included in Bradley's roster.

The athletic department said the action came on the game scheduled for November 24 after Bradley had notified FSU it would not consider playing if its Negro players were left out. Moreover, a return game at Bradley next year was also cancelled.

This is the first year that Bradley has had colored players on its varsity team. Last month the University of Tampa (white) journeyed to Peoria to play Bradley, whose mixed team beat the Floridians 34 to 6.

**Evans Founder's Day Speaker At A & T College**

GREENSBORO, N. C. — James C. Evans, civilian assistant secretary of defense of Washington, D. C., will deliver the principal address at the Founders Day celebration at A & T College on Friday morning.

The program, honoring the founders of the institution and marking fifty-eight years of service by the college will be held in the Richard B. Harrison Auditorium. It will be preceded by a special military review of the army and air force ROTC units of the college on the front campus beginning at 10 o'clock.

The speaker, who holds the A. M. degree from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, formerly headed the department of mechanic arts at West Virginia State College at Institute, W. Va. Immediately prior to assuming his present position he was the civilian aide to the secretary of the army. He is winner of the Spingarn Medal given annually by the NAACP.

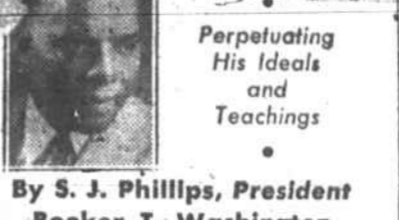

WASHINGTON BIRTHPLACE, Va.—Should imperialistic communism conquer the United States, how will Negroes fare? The question can be answered by the Poles, the Slovaks, the Chinese, the Hungarians, and the Germans. The laboring classes suffer under communism, and ninety per cent of all Negroes are included in this category. How will they fare?

Under chattel slavery—which began in 1619 at Jamestown, Virginia, and ended in 1865, Negroes saw a hard time, but it is difficult to compare their plight with the millions of slaves now under communist domination in Siberia.

It is natural for us to resent the conditions under which our forefathers lived, and to rebel against every prejudice that is thrust upon us. The conditions of second-class citizenship under which most Negroes live is also a heavy burden. Even though progress is being made through our own efforts to correct the inequities of citizenship, the majority race is slow in practicing their preachments of democracy.

There has been a revolution in "sacrificial" gifts. Dr. Bond said during a presentation ceremony in the Mary Dod Brown Chapel, he spoke the "high esteem of loyal alumni and the strong bonds which will always encircle the institution and its beloved foster sons."

An honor graduate of the class of 1893, Dr. Brown left the money for "the benefit of Lincoln University and its students."
