SUMMER MAIN DISHES BY ARMOUR AND COMPANY

Cool and add 1 cup sliced chopped cucumber, 1/2 cup sliced radishes and 1/2 cup salad dressing. Press salad into custard cups to shape and turn out dish and cucumber flowerets. Makes 4 servings.
