Goldfinch Dry Goods and Kingston Furniture Making Much Progress

**GOLDFINCH BOYS ARE SUCCESSFUL**

Will Start New Front on Main Street in Near Future

Recent changes made in the business buildings occupied by the Goldfinch Dry Goods Company and the Kingston Furniture Company, show the progress that has been made by these enterprising firms. The Kingston Furniture Company is located at the second door on main street below the front of the Goldfinch Dry Goods Company, and formerly there was a barber shop in between the two establishments.

All of this has been changed. The barber shop has long since been moved out and now by extensive and very expensive changes and alterations on the interior of these buildings, all three of the stores have been cut into one big establishment. The changes, of course, resulted in giving a great deal more room for the display of the large stocks of each concern. Juanita Johnson Taken to Hospital for Extraction of Missile

The bullet penetrated the abdominal region and the child was taken to the Burroughs Hospital for an operation for removing the missile.

At this writing the bullet had not been located in the tissues where it lodged.

Juanita is the young sister of the little boy of the same family who was taken to the same hospital a few days before that for an operation.

Not long before the accident, boys with small rifles had been seen walking along in the same section of the town. It is thought that they were using these firearms when a shot unexpectedly hit the little girl.

**POST OFFICE AND U. S. TREASURY**

Join Hands in The Encouragement of the Savings Department for People

Official announcement has been received by Postmaster Chas. R. Scarborough of Conway, S. C., of the joining of hands of the Post Office and Treasury Departments for the encouragement of the savings movement. The plan, as explained in a statement sent out by Secretary of the Treasury Mellon, provides for the stimulation of the savings habit by the acceptance of Postal Savings deposits from 10 cents up and the offering of Treasury Savings Securities from \$1 to \$1,000.

There will be no Thrift Stamp, nor War Savings Stamps offered during 1922, but all outstanding Thrift and War Savings Stamps will be redeemable precisely upon the terms upon which they were purchased. It is announced.

For the better co-ordination of the Postal and Treasury plans all who invest in Postal Savings may convert their deposits, when sufficiently large, into Treasury Savings Securities yielding 4 1-2 per cent interest compounded semi-annually, if held to maturity.

Further, the limit of individual holdings of Treasury Savings Securities has been increased from \$1,000 to \$5,000 and the 1921 issues of three of the securities bear the portraits of three great Americans—Roosevelt, Lincoln and Washington.

**CONWAY BOY IS VICTIM OF SHOT**

Telegram Received Here Gave But Few Details of Injury

**WOUNDED AS BY ACCIDENTAL SHOT**

Some Details of Accident Learned Over Telephone

A telegram received here last Saturday morning, by Mrs. A. M. Dusenbury, stated that her son, Harmon Dusenbury, had been shot by a marine, at Denmark, S. C. Expense money was asked for bringing him home. The telegram was signed J. S. Matthews. None of the details appeared in the telegram, except that it was evident that his injuries could not be considered as serious.

Members of the family got in touch with people at Denmark and it was learned that he had been shot at three times and that the wounds inflicted were two, one in the neck and the other in the foot; and that the wounds were not serious. It was also stated that he was in the care of a competent physician, Dr. Matthews; that all arrangements would be made for accompanying him home if that should become necessary. Further particulars could not be learned until later.

He arrived at home here on Saturday night. It was found that the only one of the bullets to lodge was the one in the foot. He was in fairly good condition with exception of a fever brought on by these flesh wounds.

He was placed in the hands of competent physicians.


