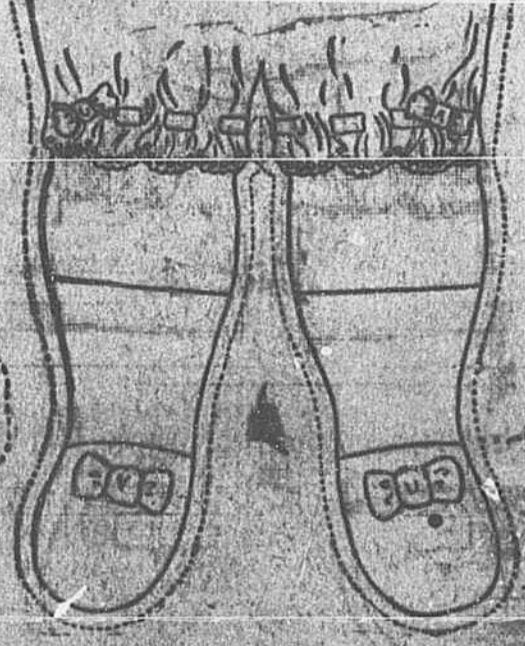

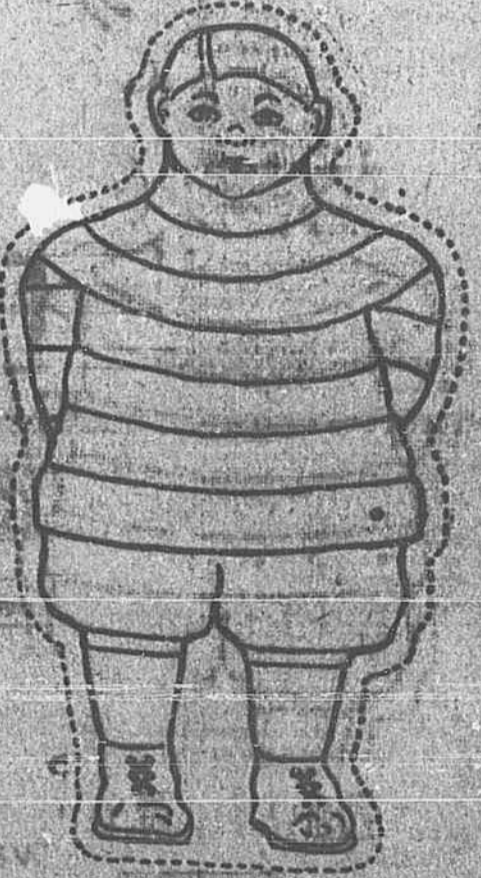


ACTUAL HEIGHT, 7 1/2 INCHES

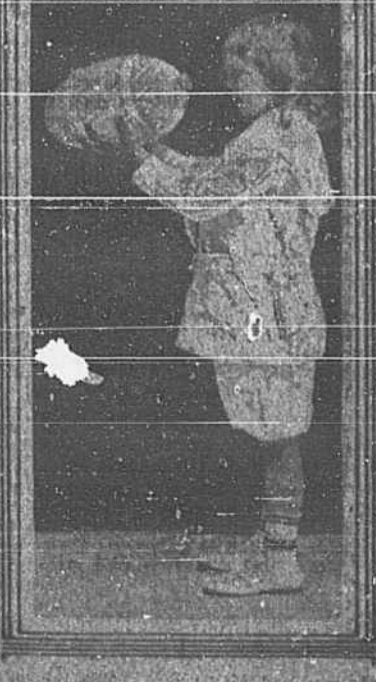
### THE EASTER EGG

### NEW YORK LETTER

By Charles Henry Adams. New York, April 4.—Shall there be a convention to revise the constitution and amend same? This question will be presented to the voters of New York State next Tuesday in a special election. The referendum is to be held in accordance with an act passed by the Democratic Legislature last December. Although there has been much talk that the constitution ought to be revised at an early date and all parties put planks to that effect in their 1912 state platforms, the political leaders have seemed strangely apathetic as to the fate of the referendum. For that reason a great majority of the people have fully realized that the date of the election was so close at hand. An unusual number of deaths from bronchitis and hemorrhoid and lobar pneumonia occurring in this city during the past month is a circumstance that has stirred the authorities to action. According to an informant statement of an official of the city Health Department, the cause of the present epidemic epidemic of the four diseases may be accounted for by the dampness caused by the delay in the removal of snow. The Salvation Army has organized a squad of workers to work on the streets of New York City each night, in a special attempt to make by as much more popular than the new dances.
