Chicago Grain

Chicago, August 1.—Wheat transactions halted to a great extent today awaiting the outcome of a movement to give exports from the United States, the protection of the American flag.

Actual condition: Loans increased \$1,182,000. Specie decreased \$53,065,000. Legal tenders decreased \$3,234,000. Net deposits decreased \$4,776,000. Circulation increased \$3,000. Banks cash reserve in vault \$314,258,000.

Trust companies cash reserve in vault \$67,182,069. Aggregate cash reserve \$411,580,000. Deficit cash reserve decrease \$43,594,500.

Trust companies reserve with clearing house members carrying 25 per cent cash reserve \$56,517,000. State banks and trust companies in greater New York, not included in clearing house statement: Loans and investments decreased \$2,239,100. Gold increased \$759,000. Currency and bank notes decrease \$57,000. Total deposits decreased \$5,516,000.
