Their fathers, husbands and brothers in the war—those of them that have not been killed by the invading Germans—the girls of Belgium have been sent down into the coal mines for the roughest kind of work. Coal miners are proverbially the hardest workers, and these girls, most of whom should be in school, must take up their task. They work with pick and shovel just like the men, and come forth grimy and dirty. Skirts are, of course, impossible. They must dress like miners to do miners' work, and accordingly the women have taken to trousers. If the war continues much longer these girls will work in mines many years after it has ended, for there will be few men left in Belgium.
