Clemson College, Feb. 14.—Friday night the new court here was the scene of a large quantity of basketball. 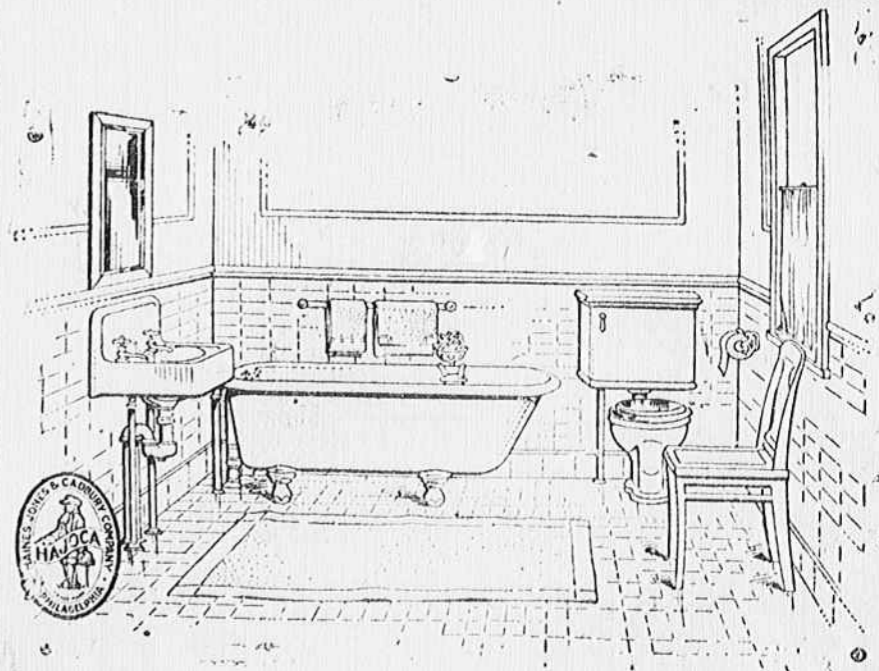
