Anderson's [wife had gone back to live with her father, which fact doubtless the Dee Beers and the Premier Mining caused the hatred of Anderson toward Carter. The killing was of a horrible nature, Carter being shot down from

the rear at the grave of his child. Some time ago Anderson shot Mr. Irving Benjamin in the face with a load from a shotgun, inflicting severe wounds. He is wanted for both these crimes.
