With the issuance Monday of a charter for the glass factory Laurens branches out into a manufacturing field that is filled with opportunities.

THE LAURENS COTTON MARKET.

There was a reaction in the cotton market yesterday, the price of the staple having advanced from 13 1/2-2 to 14 cents during the day.

Now, in this connection it may be well enough to say that because of the decline in the market last week, in New York, Augusta and other markets as well as Laurens, there has been a disposition on the part of many of our people, both town and county to "knock" Laurens.

To show that Laurens paid on the average as much as other towns in the State Monday, take these reports as published in The News and Courier yesterday from the different sections of South Carolina.

It may occasionally happen that a supply merchant allows a bonus of a few points on a bale of cotton in order to collect or to encourage his debtor, but the dealers who buy from the wagon want all the cotton they can get and pay the market price for it.

Of course we do not criticize the cotton producers for wanting all their cotton will bring on any market, the proper sampling and grading and weighing of each and every bale; and all these considerations should be accorded every man who offers his cotton for sale in Laurens.

Fairs are being held in nearly every county in the State and the grand climax will be the State Fair in Columbia next week. They are fine indications of the State's progressiveness and the day is not so far off when the county seat without a fair will be a back number.

With the disposition of the county auditor's campaign and election, it is expected that the municipal campaign will be launched.

The new depot will be unveiled in a very short time but it seems that cloth will go out of fashion before our Uncle Sam uncovers his new postoffice building here.

The Laurens cotton market, contrary to the general opinion expressed over the county, continues to hold its own among the markets of the larger towns.
