PINE TREE BEETLE KILLING THE TREES

Methods of Counteracting the Inroads of the Beetle are Discussed at Pelzer Meeting-Many Trees Dying.

In the presence of one of the most representative gatherings of farmers and timber men ever held in the Piedmont section of he state, Mr. E. B. Mason, of the Spartanburg station of Forest Insect investigation of agriculture ,delivered an address recently in Pelzer on the pine bark beetle, its destructive work and the best

means of preventing and destroying it. The audience was composed of representative farmers all of whom had been heavy losers of timber because of the destructive ravages of the insect. Many of them came from the distance of 20 or more miles, while there were one or two from Laurens,

Anderson and other parts of the state. He stated that the pine bark beetle had been with us for years, but only in the last few years had scientists discovered that it was what was destroying the pine timber throughout the South, and only recently had its ravages grown to such an extent as it He said that the beetle usually riddle a tree and kill it in 30 days. He cited instances where as much as 45 acres have been killed


