AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO RAISE SUP-PLIES FOR THE YEAR 1915. State of South Carolina, County of Laurens, City of Laurens.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAU-RENS, IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED: Section 1. That no person, firm or corporation shall, after the first day of January, 1915, engage in, prosecute or carry on any business or profession hereafter named, within the corporate limits of the City of Laurens, without having first paid a special license tax therefor. The amount of said special license tax shall be the amount placed opposite each occupation, business or profession herein below named, respectively, and the amount shall be the cost of said special tax per annum, unless otherwise specified, to wit:
