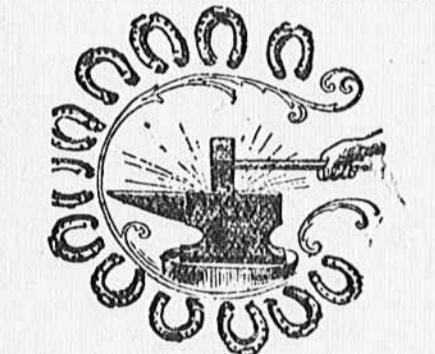

RENDERS OPINION ON BEER BREWERY.

Sales Must Stop Under Prohibition Act. Requested by Board.

Columbia, Oct. 1.—The attorney general's office yesterday rendered an opinion that a brewery in Charleston can not sell beer to the dispensaries after the result of the prohibition election has been declared by the State board of canvassers. The opinion was written by Fred H. Dominick, assistant attorney general, upon request of John Marshall, secretary of the Charleston county dispensary board.

The following is the opinion in full: "I am in receipt of yours of the 22nd instant addressed to the attorney general, in which you say that the Germania Brewing company of Charleston holds a license for manufacturing beer and that the prohibition act prohibits the dispensary board from buying, contracting for or receiving liquors after the declaration of the result of the election. You ask to be advised as to whether or not, under these circumstances, you can receive beer manufactured by the Germania Brewing company after the declaration of the result of said election.

"In reply thereto I will say that the prohibition act, in section 4 thereof, provides that 'no liquor shall be bought or contracted for or received by any county dispensary board after the result of said election is declared by the State board of canvassers.'

"Under section 859 of the criminal code of 1912, which section refers to the manufacture and sale of liquor by distillers and beer by breweries, it is provided that such manufacturers shall not sell such liquors and beverages to any person, firm or corporation within the limits of this state, except to county dispensary boards.

"It will be seen from the provisions of law quoted that the brewery can only sell to the county dispensary boards. Under the prohibition act the county dispensary board can not buy, contract for or receive any liquor which, of course, will include beer, after the result of the election is declared by the State board of canvassers.

"I am of the opinion that this provision of the prohibition act will apply to a brewery that has been licensed in this State in the same manner as to any brewery outside of the State. In other words, that after the result of the election has been declared by the State board of canvassers the county dispensary board has no power or authority, under the law, in my opinion, to buy, contract for or receive any liquor or beer from any source whatsoever."

CLIFF GODFREY RETAINS COUNSEL

Men Who Killed Robert Hanna Last Week Will be Represented by Sanders and DePass.

Spartanburg, Oct. 2.—Cliff Godfrey, who killed Robert L. Hanna near Enoree Friday morning of last week, has retained the firm of Sanders & DePass of this city as his counsel. Godfrey surrendered to officers at Woodruff the morning after the killing and has since been held in the county jail here on the charge of murder.

The attorneys said yesterday that they could not as yet make any statements as to whether or not steps would be taken looking towards the procuring of bail for the accused.

The next term of the court of general sessions convenes in November and the Godfrey case will most likely come before the grand jury at that term, though, of course, it cannot be said as yet that the actual trial of the case will take place at the coming term.

The trial of Godfrey will probably be attended by a throng of spectators as Robert Hanna was quite well known in the Enoree section of the county and had taken a leading hand in politics on occasions. He was shot at Godfrey's home early Friday morning and died the Saturday afternoon following. So far in the case, a motive for the killing has not been definitely brought out and it is not improbable that there may be some new developments during the trial.
