

ancellation of Contracts Prevents Expenditures of More Than One Billion Dollars.

Washington, Nov. 21. - Savings arough war departmental readjustent orders, including cancellation of ontracts, are estimated at \$1,336,000, 00 by Secretary Baker in a letter read to the senate today by Senator Martin of Virginia, chairman of the appropriations committee.

"On contracts which have been let, ut on which no work has as yet been done," Mr. Baker wrote, "cancellations ggregate a saving of \$700,000,000.

"An order was made on the 11th of November cutting out all overtime and Sunday work. The amount saved by this order aggregates about \$2,900,000

"In the bureau of aircraft producion orders have been telegraphed stopping all production on a large number of items which aggregate the estimated saving of \$225,000,000.

"In addition to the foregoing, plans have been made to begin the demobthis country and to begin returning at once to the United States such por-

tions of the armed forces abroad as are not needed for the purpose of oc-






