SOLDIER INSURANCE MAY BE CONVERTED

Government to Furnish Cheap Insurance to Discharged Soldiers.

Soldiers who have been discharged are now wondering what they should do with the insurance they held in service. For their information and guid ance in this matter, the following data has been secured from the Camp In surance Officer, Camp Jackson, S. C. The facts set forth are condensed. If Insurance Officer, Camp Jackson, S. C.

The policy now held by all soldiers is "term" insurance. Checks for premiums should be made payable to the Treasurer of the United States, and Risk Insurance, Washington, D. C., monthly. This form of policy insures the holder against death and total at present rates until five years and Peace. This form of insurance is cheaper than any other issued by the Government or commercial life insurance companies.

At any time after April and within five years after the signing of the Peace Treaty, the present policy may be converted into any of six prefered Government policies.
