Fusarium vilt starts in the roots and spreads into the stem, leaves and fruit. Its most common symptom is a yellowing of the leaves which slow-

There are several other tomato diseases such as leaf spot, Bacterial wilt, Sclerotium wilt and root knot, which may be confused with Fusarium wilt. Leaf spot destroys the leaves but not the stems, and small circular spots appear on the stem and leaves, but there is no blackening under the bark,

Bacterial wilt is somewhat similar to Fusarium wilt, but it kills the leaves quickly and the whole plant often dies in a few days. It causes a blackening frequently extends into the pith. The sap may often be drawn out into strings by touching it with the fingers.

Selerotium wilt usually starts in the stem at the surface of the ground, It covers the affected area with reddish brown bodies about the size of mustard




