AN ORDINANCE,

Imposing a License Tax on Persons Who Engage in, Prosecute or Carry on Any Business or Profession in the City of Laurens.

State of South Carolina, County of Laurens, City of Laurens.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAU-RENS:

The City Clerk shall thereupon as-50 sess and collect the proper license tax as provided for in this Ordinance, and upon such tax being paid, shall issue to the applicant the proper

license. Sec. 7. For any business, trade, occupation or profession not enumerated in Section 1 of this Ordinance, the license shall be fixed by the City Council of the City of Laurens at any regular or special meeting thereof.

Sec. 8. The license taxes herein imposed are levied for the purpose of raising funds to meet the annual ordinary expenses of the City of Laurens for the fiscal year commoncing on the 1st day of January of any year hereafter and for the purpose of paying in whole or in part any legal in-debtedness of the said City incurred for ordinary expenses thereof falling

due during the said fiscal year. Sec. 9. This Ordinance shall go into effect on the 1st day of January A. D. 1920. 1.00
