New Uniforms. The Newberry Rifles received forty new uniforms recently from Philadelphia. They were sent to the Rifles by order of the War Department. Cotton Seed Oil Mill. At a meeting of the Directors held on Monday, T. M. Neill was elected President, and Geo. S. Mower, attorney. The order for the engine and boiler was placed. The Beck Automatic engine was purchased from the Taylor Manufacturing Company, of Chambersburg, Pa., and the boiler was bought from the Milburn Machine Works, Memphis, Tenn. Aquittal in the Senn Case. SPARTANBURG, S. C., August 5.—The jury in the Senn and Doland case retired shortly before seven o'clock, after remaining out about half an hour brought in a verdict of acquittal. The case has occupied two days.—Special to Greenville News.

David X. Senn and Helena Doland were tried for the killing of Mosella Senn, the wife of the former. Senn and his wife and the woman Doland were travelling with a wagon and the tragedy was enacted on the road four years ago. The parties were convicted at a former trial of the case. An appeal was taken to the Supreme Court and a new trial ordered, which ends in an acquittal. The case has cost the County of Spartanburg, the correspondent of the News and Courier estimates, from \$2,000 to \$2,500—not including the recent trial. The regular County Campaign as ordered by the Board of Supervisors opened on last Saturday at Wallington's in No. 2 Township. The editor of The Herald and News went down to see and hear the machine put in operation. The attendance was small and the enthusiasm was less. In fact, no one seemed to be interested very much one way or the other. The candidates spoke, but there was not a particle of applause given any speaker, and the voters appeared almost indifferent.
