Maryland Pudding. A Maryland plum pudding, warranted to keep a year, is made from six pounds of seeded raisins, six pounds of brown sugar, four pounds of currants, six pounds of stoned oatmeal, six pounds of suet chopped very fine, six pounds of eggs, two pounds of citron, six table-spoonfuls of flour, half a pint of wine, half a pint of brandy, three nutmegs and three lemons and six allspice.
