The proportion of children to adult population in the South seems to be much greater than in the Northern or Western States.

The following figures, calculated from statistics in the United States Census, show that from this standpoint the burden of education in the Southern States is much heavier than in other sections of the country.

In Tennessee there are 65 adult males to every 100 children between five and twenty years old; in Virginia, 63; North Carolina, 59; South Carolina, 57; Georgia, 56; Mississippi, 55; Texas, 49; Ohio, 47; Michigan, 47; New York, 42; Rhode Island, 40; Massachusetts, 40; Connecticut, 40; Washington, 39; California, 39; Montana, 38.
