RACE ISSUE IN THE NAVY.

A Washington special to The State of yesterday says:

At the New York navy yard the race question has arisen as the result of the enlistment of a negro as chief carpenter's mate on board the receiving ship Columbia. He is the only negro on board that vessel and the white jacksies declare they will not sit at mess with him. Several days ago when the first came to mess the white petty officers left the room and since that time they have declined to come to their messes until the offensive negro had left the table. The matter has not yet reached an official status and it is difficult to state what the outcome will be.

This instance is one of many of a similar character frequently arising in the navy as a result of the enlistment of negroes. Requiring the political difficulties in the way the officers and men of the navy generally try to settle these matters without reference to the department. But it is a fact that eventually the question will be put squarely before Secretary Moody and by him before the president. Does the navy need the negro?

Of an enlisted force of about 28,000 men in the navy today only 500 are negroes. Examination of the records shows that the black contingent is decreasing and navy officers who are asked for the reason for this declare that the class of negroes applying for enlistment is far lower than the lowest of the whites who come up for examination. They feel that it is a race question and not a question of negroes as such.

Conditions which exist and are unchangeable save by time and so far as human eye can see, but even it is changed by time must be recognized. The negro is not the white man's equal socially and will not be so regarded by the white man. President Roosevelt and Secretary Moody and the whole Republican administration will want in time. The president's efforts to force social equality will be more quickly cause him to learn. The question will be settled finally by the removal of the negro.
