THE FINAL RESULT.

HOW THE STATE AND COUNTY WENT IN THE SECOND PRIMARY.

McSweeney's Majority Runs up to Nearly 14,000. Jim Tillman's for Lieutenant Governor Larger.

The State Democratic executive committee met Friday in Columbia and declared the result of the second primary election as follows:

For Governor, Miles B. McSweeney 51,352, James A. Hoyt 37,411; Lieutenant Governor, Jas. H. Tillman 53,690, J. T. Sloan 34,798; Railroad Commissioner, J. H. Wharton 45,912, W. D. Evans 42,522.
