Though her body sleeps in the cemetery at Kingstree beside her devoted sister, Mrs. Clarkson, her spirit sleeps nowhere, for it still lives and speaks in the souls of those who knew her and will henceforth forever be busy taking in the raptures of glory and giving out in notes of ever-increasing melody and power the song of Moses and the Lamb!
