Work of Chaingang—School Building Enlarged—Negro Marauder Still at Large.

BENSON, August 10:—Tobacco planters of this section have finished curing the weed and, we understand, are very well satisfied with prices paid at the warehouses in Kingstree.

For the want of rain corn and cotton have suffered and the prospect of a crop is poorer than was estimated a few weeks ago.

Misses Ruby Graham of Cades and Omie Snowden of Indian-town have been visiting friends here recently.

The patrons of the Cedar Swamp Graded school have proved their loyalty to the cause of education by some of them going down into their pockets and giving money and furnishing lumber to add another story to the present building, which is inadequate in size to accommodate the increasing number of pupils. Messrs T M Kellahan, J Y McGill and W E Snowden, the trustees, are making every effort to have the contractor do a creditable job and at the same time complete the work in time for the opening of the school term.

The services of Misses Volina Ouzts and Carrie Lander, who taught here last year, have been secured again. Also Miss Lena Miley of Hampton, who is a graduate of Winthrop College and comes very highly recommended as a teacher of experience, has been added to the faculty for the ensuing term.
