TO ABOLISH COMMON DRINKING CUP.

Board of Health Takes Step to Eliminate Relic of Primitive Times.

Columbia, January 24.—The state board of health has started a crusade, to eliminate the public drinking cup from the state on the ground that the cup is a dangerous spreader of infectious diseases. A bill will likely be introduced in the Legislature abolishing the common cup in public places, including schools, waiting rooms and railroad trains.

Dr Williams, secretary of the State board of health, is exhibiting a supply of individual paper drinking cups which are placed in a small vendor near the water cooler in the office of the board. In North Carolina the board of health condemned the common cup last July. Authorities have proved that germs of diphtheria, tuberculosis and other more loathsome diseases are conveyed from sick persons to healthy ones on the brim of drinking cups in public places.

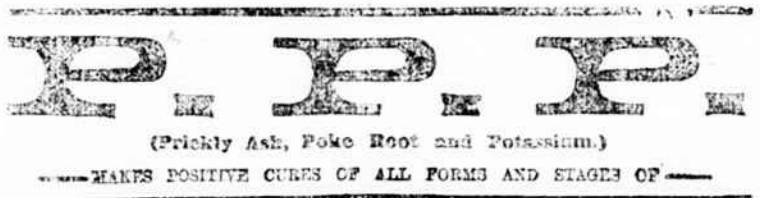
A County Fair for Clarendon.

Manning, January 21.—Some weeks ago the Manning board of trade appointed a committee to investigate and report on the advisability of holding a county fair at Manning some time during the fall of 1910. The committee consisted of C R Sprott, F P Ervin and W E Jenkinson, all prominent citizens. They went to work at once corresponding with fair associations in other counties and seeking information from all available sources. At the call of this committee a meeting of business and professional men was held in the town hall today. The committee made a favorable and enthusiastic report, and the meeting resolved unanimously that the organization of a county fair association should be undertaken at once. The special committee was continued and instructed to apply to the Secretary of State for a charter, and as an evidence of good faith subscriptions to a large portion of the necessary capital stock were pledged on the spot.

The Manning board of trade has already done good work along special lines, such as fostering the tobacco raising industry in Clarendon county and offering prizes for the encouragement of the boys' corn clubs. It is safe to predict that they will see to it that the Clarendon county fair is also made a success.

The office of the Supervisor of Registration will be open on the 1st Monday in each month for the purpose of registering any person who is qualified as follows:
Who shall have been a resident of the State for two years, and of the county one year, and of the polling precinct in which the elector offers to vote four months before the day of election, and shall have paid, six months before, any poll tax then due and payable, and who can both read and write any section of the constitution of 1895 submitted to him by the Supervisors of Registration, or who can show that he owns, and has paid all taxes collectable on during the present year, property in this State assessed at three hundred dollars or more.

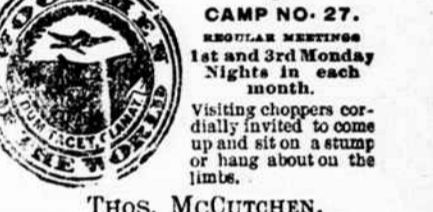
