FARMERS' UNION MEETING.

Various Matters of Interest Considered and Passed Upon.

Williamsburg County Farmers' Union met in the court house on Saturday, November 18, at 11 a. m., President H J Brown presiding. Nine local unions were represented. The cotton warehouse matter was taken up and satisfactorily adjusted. The cotton pledge formulated at the State meeting at Columbia on November 2 was approved and all farmers, whether or not members of the union, are requested to sign same, especially as to the reduction of acreage. Mr H O Britton, Clerk of Court, has several copies of the pledge in his office, and will be glad to have any and all farmers to sign same.

The fertilizer question was discussed and farmers are requested to buy fertilizers on terms that their notes be made to mature February 1, instead of October and November 1, as is the case now. Messrs J J M Graham, W O Camlin and W D Daniel were appointed by the county union to confer with the business men and secure their co-operation in this matter. Also each local union was requested to appoint a committee of three to agitate and work to this end.

The secretary was requested to write President Dabbs and ask him to call a meeting of the Farmers' Union and business men to meet in Columbia at an early date.

The union then adjourned to meet on Thursday, December 7, at 11 o'clock a. m. J T FRIERSON, Sec'y W C F U.
