TO VOTERS OF SOUTH CAROLINA

And Especially Those of Sixth Congressional District.

It was General Grant, we believe, who gave utterance to the expression "That the Democratic party could be relied upon to do the wrong thing at the right time." This not only referred to measures but to men, and he was in part correct. The ambition of our politicians caused many dissensions and bickerings in our party and gave to the opposition ammunition to fight us with. With the exception of Washington, the two Adamses, Harrison and Taylor the Democrats elected all of their Presidents to the time of Lincoln, and could have remained in power but for the ambition of Stephen A Douglas, who endeavored to foist upon the party a platform antagonistic to Democratic faith. The consequence was that when the Democratic party met in Baltimore, after having failed to nominate at Charleston, S C, a split took place and two Democratic candidates entered the field. The consequence was Lincoln was elected. That brought on war, and upon its war record the Republican party has kept in power. Not altogether that. This party allied itself with the trusts and corporations, and we have as a result of their dominion the unrest of the country and the high price of living. The result of the war left the South prostrate and in poverty, while to the North all was roseate. Money obtained from Government contracts was plenty, and from that arose the corporate and trust influence which has kept the Republican party in power.

A dawn has come. The blackness of a night of despair to the people of the South gives promise of a brighter day, if we of the South will do away with personal preferences and retain in Congress men of experience rather than send men with no experience. They may tell you on the stump of the shortcomings of their predecessors, and tell you what they will do. Believe them not unless they prove their cause beyond a reasonable doubt. Unless they can produce testimony beyond themselves, let the man in Congress stay, for it takes several years for a Congressman to be of any use to his constituents. Before the war the South had the say in Governmental affairs. Why? Because she kept her Senators and Representatives in Congress as long as they proved competent, while the North made changes. Since the war the result has been changed, and the consequence is that by reason of the politician appealing to the people as to what he will do, and he knows that he can't accomplish it, and that while he may be a big man in county affairs he will be a Lilliputian when he gets into Congress, changes are made and the South has no influence and gets less than we are entitled to from the public treasury.

Now, J E Ellerbe is the Representative from the Sixth Congressional district. He has held that position for several terms and has been advanced as only a member of experience can be, to a position on the committee of rivers and harbors. This not only makes him a Representative from the Sixth Congressional district, but from the whole State. A new man going in could not expect to get on that important committee. Outside of Mr Ellerbe's duties, well performed, as to the State at large, he, under the most

trying circumstances, has gotten public buildings for Darlington, Bennettsville and Marion and a site for a building at Dillon. Could we expect anything more from our Representative in the face of the fact that South Carolina was the first to precipitate the war and it is held against us? Certainly not. Then whom can we put in his place that would do more? Consider that voters. He has not only done that, but has put rural delivery routes all over the Sixth district. Then why remove him? Can anyone else do as well? He is there with the experience of years. Can an amateur, for such would be his successor, do what he has done? We say no.

Therefore, we say to you voters of South Carolina and the Sixth Congressional District, in particular, return Ben Tillman to the Senate and J E Ellerbe to the House. Let not the idea that your candidate is a county man, and we should support him, influence you. This is a fallacy and might lead to incompetent officials. But by your vote accept the best man for the place.

Woodrow Wilson is going to be your next President and he will want a Congress of men of experience; men who have served in Congress and know the wants of the country. You could not get in the Sixth District a better man than your present Representative, J E Ellerbe, and in the State a better man than your Senator, B R Tillman.

I have no personal feeling, but am actuated by a desire for the good of the people of South Carolina.
