

THE Charleston Fair Association

Will hold its Second Annual Agricultural and Industrial Exhibition during the week of November 17 to 22, 1913. In many respects this is to be the most unique Fair ever held in this or any other place in the country. Children's Day

Monday, the opening day of the Fair, will be Children's Day. "The Palmetto Goat Derby" will be the feature attraction, consisting of goat cart races driven by school children. In addition there will be a dozen or more other interesting and amusing races and children's games to occupy the whole afternoon.

Athletic Day

These drivers handle their machines with the same ease and turn the same same tricks in their machines as an expert skater does on skates. This feature is the latest act shown at fairs and has never been in the South.
