Whereas, the Town Council of Kingstree, S. C., by resolution duly passed and adopted in Council assembled on September 9th, 1919, has ordered and directed the regular election of municipal officers in and for said Town to be held at the County Court House in said Town on September 23rd, 1919, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Six Aldermen, and a commissioner of public Works in and for said Town:

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given that pursuant to said resolution, and as required by law, the regular municipal officers in and for the Town of Kingstree, S. C., will be held at the County Court House in said Town on September 23rd, 1919, the same being the fourth Tuesday of said month, at which said election the duly qualified registered voters of said Town shall vote for a Mayor and six Aldermen of and for said Town whose term of office shall continue for a period of two years and until their successors shall be elected and qualified, and for a Commissioner of Public Works in and for said Town whose term of office shall continue for a period of six years and until his successors shall be elected and qualified; that for the purpose of conducting said election, A. M. Gordon, M. H. Plowden and R. M. Vause have been appointed Managers of Election, and that the polls shall be opened at eight o'clock in the forenoon and closed at four o'clock in the afternoon on the date prescribed for said election as aforesaid.

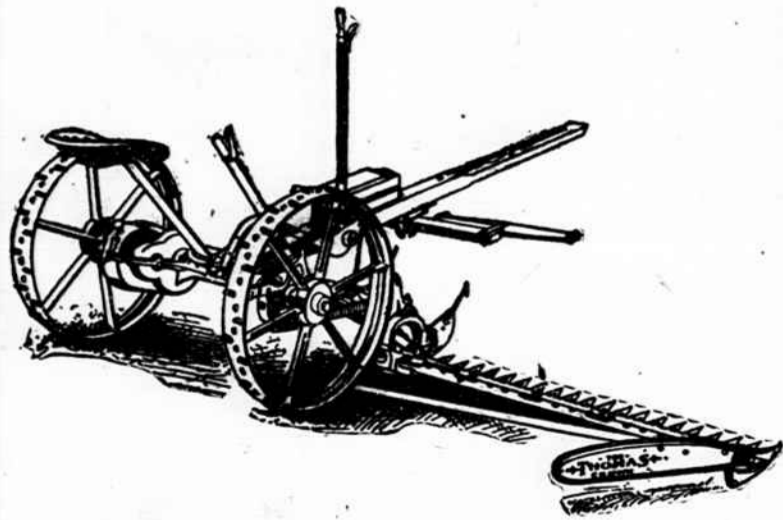
