### MURDER SUSPECT IS SHOT

Man In Act of Boarding Train Officer Call "Halt."

Miami, Fla., Feb. 1.—David Atkins, of Arch Creek, 12 miles north of this city, who is thought by the police to be the man wanted in connection with the murder of E. C. Bell at Arch Creek, whose body was found in Arch Creek yesterday, was wounded, probably fatally early to day by Police Lieutenant E. J. Starling.

The shooting occurred near the railway station. Starling and Patrolman Harry Morris identified Atkins as the young man who had been living with Bell. They believe he was about to board a north bound train and called to him. Instead of replying, he is said to have attempted to draw a weapon from his pocket.

Two of Starlings' three shots were effective, one grazing Atkins arm and the other entering his shoulder. He dropped to the ground and a revolver fell from his hand. Two residents of Arch Creek identified Atkins as the man who had lived with Bell for a short time.

An alligator ten feet long was devouring Bells body when it was discovered by neighbors. Bell's right arm had been broken, his chest and back severely bruised.

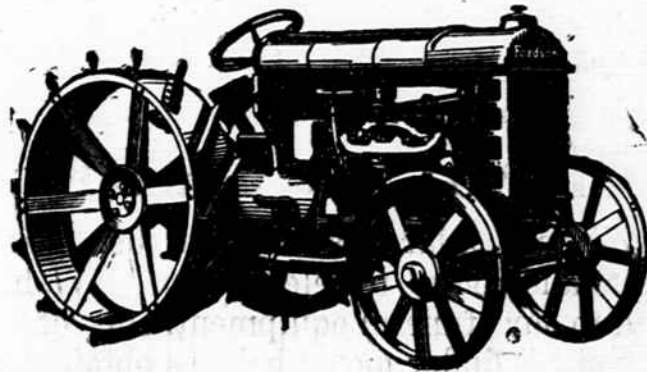
