"It is not generally known that at the last session of the general assembly the school law was amended by imposing a penalty on parents who neglected to register with the chairman of the board of trustees on or before August 15 the names of their children between the ages of 7 and 14 years.

"Failure to comply with the law makes the parent subject to a fine of not less than \$5 nor more than \$10 or imprisonment for not less than 5 nor more than 10 days.

"The law applies to those counties which abolished the office of truant officer, but as this office was abolished in many counties last year, the law is almost state-wide in its application.

"If you do not want to come in conflict with the law you had better conflict with the law you had better see that your child's name and age are registered with the chairman of your board of trustees on or before your board of trustees on or before the 15th of this month."

But with this difference: Our hard times, our lean times never last for so ong as seven years.



As a matter of fact, the times now are not as bad as they might be, and they are not as bad as they have ofen been before.-Selected.


