MR. BRYAN'S CAMPAIGN PLAN.

Friend Says He Will Not Make Train Specials and Will Not Attack Corporations.

A dispatch from Lincoln, Nebraska, Jennings Bryan, as outlined by a close friend and stalwart supporter:/ "Mr. Bryan," the friend said, "is a genius endowed with the passion for hard work. He has outlined plans for a presidential campaign, the most determined, resolute, and at the same time the most dignified in the history of the nation. He has no

doubt of his nomination. "At his home at Fairview, Mr. Bryan will receive delegations from all parts of the country. Speches will be made but they will be quiet dignified addresses.

"In the life of Mr. Bryan nothing has come by chance. When he planned to charm a convention with his oratory he worked on his effort for a year in advance. When he planned to capture the following demoeratic nomination by acclamation he went about it in the same manner. After his St. Louis convention espiode he participated in the campaign enough to show his good will. Then he outlined a globe trotting tour which attracted the attention of the

"Soon after Mr. Bryan's return Fairview will be remodelled and a large porch will be added. Landscape gardens will transform the rolling lawn into a garden where ten thousand persons may hear a political speech.

"Mr. Bryan will not rush around the country in special trains. He will make but two trips. He will deliver one masterpiece, an oration which will be carefully planned and will contain such matchless Bryannic paragraphs. As for the remainder of the speches, they will be full of dignity. Just before the campaign closes Mr. Bryan will make another supreme appeal.

"Mr. Bryan will not join in the extreme and radical ideas like those of Mr. LaFollette, and he will be moderate in his expressions, as compared with Mr. Roosevelt. Instead of scaring capital he will reassure. Trusts he will urge, should be curbed, but curbed with no injustice to capitalist or investor.

"Mr. Bryan will not interfere with the sentiments of his party. He will act in an indifferent manner toward endorsements and urge the claims of any one who should aspire to the nomination. At the same time the endorsements will come with such frequency that it will be extremely discouraging for the opposing candi-

"Mr. Hearst will be humored and Mr. Parker ignored. During the months after his return to Lincoln Mr. Bryan will make public his idea of the political systems of foreign countries. All the while he will be directing the views of the national democratic organization in a safe and sane

"In this his own State it will take all Bryan's diplomacy to prevent a factional breach. These hostile factions must be placated before Mr. Bryan returns, and he will do his best to organize the State for a democratic victory in 1908. Mayor Dahlman is a royal partisan of Bryan and his election in Omaha means much to the Fairview statesman. Another piece of good luck was the election of Mayor Brown, a staunch Democrat in Lincoln."

A CURE FOR ICE IMPOSITION.

An Ohio Judge Comes to the Public's

Toledo, Ohio, June 25 .- In the Common Pleas Cuort today Judge says: Here are the plans of William Kinkade imposed the maximum sentence of \$5,000 fine and one year imprisonment in the workhouse on each of five men, found guilty of conspiracy in restraint of trade.

> Hearings on motions in arrest of execution cannot be heard for some time and the men will stand committed until the fines are paid or the sentence otherwise disposed of.

> All of the men are prominent in business and social circles. They were taken to the county jail to await the making out of the necessary papers to commit them to the work house unless in the meantim they meet Judge Kinkaide's propsition to make restitution to the public. These men were indicted for combining to restrain trade in violation of the Valen-

Under the pretext that ice supply was much smaller than in recent years, these dealers combined and advanced the price to 50 to 100 per cent. They were indicted, and one of them stood trial, but was convicted. The others entered pleas of guilty. The sentence is the maximum under the law. If they would es pe any part of it they must pay bac. to customers all overcharges and must agree to sell ice at the price prior to forming the combination. The law provides for imprisonment as well as a fine and if the men go to the work house they will be put at hard labor. Two or three of them are worth at least \$100,000 each.


