Washington, Aug. 15.—Officials here expect acceptance of the Pan-American peace plan for Mexico from Gen. Villa, Angeles and other leaders in Northern Mexico, within a few days.

Another indication of the Carranza faction's opposition to any outside interference into Mexican affairs was contained in dispatches made public by Villa's Washington agent from Jesus Acuna, minister of foreign affairs at Vera Cruz quoting a statement to newspaper men in Mexico City last night by Gen. Pablo Gonzales, the Carranza commandant.
